Represented by the buffalo

BE HONEST FIRST WITH YOURSELF AND YOU WILL MORE EASILY BE ABLE TO BE HONEST WITH OTHERS

TO WALK THROUGH LIFE WITH INTEGRITY IS TO KNOW HONESTY

### HUMILITY DABAADENDIZIWIN

Represented by the wolf

IT IS TO KNOW YOURSELF AS A SACRED PART OF CREATION

YOU ARE EQUAL TO OTHERS BUT YOU ARE NOT BETTER

DO NOT BECOME ARROGANT AND SELF-IMPORTANT

### TRUTH DEBWEWIN

Represented by the turtle

BE TRUE TO YOURSELF AND ALL OTHER THINGS

SHOW HONOR AND SINCERITY IN ALL THAT YOU SAY AND DO

DO NOT DECEIVE YOURSELF OR OTHERS
